**Resolution 05.27.20:2** Attorney Brandon Voelker read a resolution adopting and approving the execution of the agreement with Texas Bluegrass Biodiesel for issuance of bonds up to \$25,000,00.

**MOTION:** Joyce Carson made motion to approve **Resolution 05.27.2020:2** adopting and approving the execution of agreement with Texas Bluegrass Biodiesel bonds, seconded by Shannon Johnson. Motion carried by vote of 4-0-0.
